

Name of the activity: Snow White

Number of students: 12 (male)

Age of the students: 25 – 45

Aim: to learn adjectives

Description of the activity

Students are divided into group of three.

One of the students is Snow White and the other two are dwarfs. The dwarfs have to convince the Snow White which one of them is better to become the Snow White's husband. The decision is, of course, up to Snow White.

Example:

Snow White: I need a husband. I'll marry one of you, the better one.

Dwarf No.1: I am **rich**.

Dwarf No.2: I am **handsome**.

Dwarf No.1: I am **healthy**.

Dwarf No.2: I am **nice**.

Dwarf No.1: I am **polite**.

Dwarf No.2: I am **hot**.

Dwarf No.1: I am **big**.

Dwarf No.2: I am **dangerous**.

Dwarf No.1: I am **strong**.

Dwarf No.2: I am **fast**.

Dwarf No.1: I am **attractive**

Then Snow White decides who is going to be her husband.

It is always difficult to know if the activity is the "right one" for adults and it is a little bit risky but this time, students liked the activity very much and they had fun.
