

Name of the activity: A new creature

Number of students: 12 (male)

Age of the students: 25 - 45

Aim: students learn to describe a person without the teacher's help

Description of the activity

One student had to come to the board and draw a shape of a human body. Then he had to ask every student "What does he or she look like?" Each student had to say one sentence to create a creature, e.g. "He has short hair." The students changed their roles during the activity.
